Middletown Mountain Biking Team gives kids a positive outlet for exercise, social interaction, and team building. This mountain biking team was founded on the ideas of: Building Strong Minds, Bodies, Character, and Community through Cycling

#7 JUSTIFICATION

Middletown Mountain Biking Team is a Non-Profit Organization that it made up of 100% volunteers. Middletown Mountain Biking Team depends on donations to assist with necessary items.

Several of the team practice rides are either at Boggs Mountain (Cobb), Big Canyon Road (Middletown), or Six Sigma Winery (Lower Lake). Not to mention several other places we will travel to including races throughout the North State. These locations put our youth riders at risk due to lack of emergency services in close proximity. Through generous donations Middletown Mountain Biking Team has supported our volunteer coaches to become First Aid trained. The majority of our coaches are now First Aid trained or higher and need necessary First Aid supplies to provide care to our youth riders and/or coaches.

#7.1 INTENDED USE OF FUNDS

These funds will allow the team to purchase enough First Aid supplies for each coach. We are also looking to use funds to purchase portable radios to increase safety in areas that lack cell service. We would also like to continue sending more coaches to First Aid training to have all of our coaches First Aid Certified.

#7.2 HOW INTENDED USE OF FUNDS WILL FURTHER DELIVERY OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES WITHIN REDBUD HEALTH CARE DISTRICT

The majority of Mountain Bike Practices and one race are within the Redbud Health Care District. By supporting the purchase of First Aid supplies our coaches will be able to provide basic First Aid to our youth, Coaches and families. By providing basic first aid to cuts and scrapes this will support Redbud Health Care Services by reducing the impact on Emergency Department visits.
