## **Background and Basic Information Regarding Organization**

Compelled by its mission of "Living God's love by inspiring health, wholeness and hope," Adventist Health Clear Lake offers acute, primary, specialty and behavioral health services to a service area of nearly 70,000 residents. Annually, Adventist Health Clear Lake provides more than 125,000 medical office visits, 20,000 emergency department visits, 50,000 outpatient visits and 1,500 hospital admissions. It operates a 25-bed critical access hospital in Clearlake and nine rural health medical offices throughout Lake County.

One of its services is the Baby Sleep Safe – Comprehensive Perinatal Services Program (CPSP). This program guides mothers through their pregnancy and postpartum journeys to give every mother and her baby a healthy start. Its goal is to enhance each woman's knowledge of maternity through education and community support. After all, much of what is known about pregnancy is only seen from the outside through the physical changes in the body. The CPSP program helps a woman understand what is happening throughout the course of her pregnancy, from fetal development, emotions, hormonal changes to postpartum care. Each appointment is guided by three assessments: Health Education, Nutrition and Psychosocial. The CPSP program culminates with Baby Sleep Safe, which is preparation and support for a "Safe Sleep" environment.

#### Justification

### Intended Use of Funds in Detail

According to the CDC, there are about 3,400 sudden unexpected infant deaths in the United States every year. In 2020, approximately 27% of the sudden unexpected infant deaths were due to accidental suffocation and strangulation in bed. To prevent these tragedies, the American Association of Pediatrics recommends that "infants be placed to sleep on their backs on a firm mattress in their own crib or bassinet, with no blankets, sheets, pillows, stuffed animals, crib bumpers, positioners or other items." The Comprehensive Perinatal Services Program educates new parents on developing a Safe Sleep environment for their infants.

To mitigate disparities, the Childbirth Educator identifies mothers experiencing financial hardship among the Baby Sleep Safe participants. After attending all their appointments, these mothers receive a free baby bundle that includes a pack-n-play or bassinet and other baby essentials to support safe sleep and overall infant health. Without this support, these mothers would not be able to afford these items.

On average, approximately 100 individuals who are in need participate in the CPSP per year.

The Childbirth Educator intends to use the funds provided to purchase a combination of up to 100 Safety  $1^{\text{st}}$  Pack-n-Plays and Bassinets, 100 HALO Safe Sleep Swaddles, 50 Safety  $1^{\text{st}}$  baby thermometers and 50 non-branded diaper bags. All sleep products are Safe Sleep Certified through Safety  $1^{\text{st}}$  and HALO Safe Sleep.

<u>How Intended Use of Funds Will Further Delivery of Health Care Services Within Redbud Health Care District</u>

The program is entirely based out of the Clearlake Clinic and serves OB patients from all areas in Lake County. Patients will be provided with high-quality, safety-tested products for their newborn(s), ensuring a safe sleep environment.
